

#### G2 Viego (2022)


Splashart I created for my own skin design for the League of Legends champion Viego in a female version.

#### Past - Present - Future (Part I)

The first part of the biggest of my projects "Past - Present - Future", I did at the League of Legends World Championship 2021. This part represents the past, the loss versus Damwon Gaming, who got to be the winner of the World Championship in 2020, and Fun Plus Pheonix, the winner of 2019.

Every part has its own name, that is hidden somewhere in the picture itself, in this case "Honor the Previous" written in the clouds in background.



#### Past - Present - Future (Part II) (2021)

The second part of this project represents the recent events before Worlds 2021, when G2 didn't manage to get a spot to compete in the turnament. Behind the portraited players of G2, Mad Lions, Rogue and Fnatic, I placed the LEC winners wall to show the fall of G2 in 2021. Again, the name of the part, "Kings of Europe", is hidden in the piece itself in shards falling from the sky.






#### Past - Present - Future (Part III)

The third part is called "We fall together" and shows the fans of LEC falling together with their teams after losing in the World Championship. For this part I have taken fan comissions of LEC fans who wanted to get drawn for the project. The name is hidden in the destroyed flags.



#### Past - Present - Future (Part IV)

The last part of "Past - Present - Future" shall portrait the future as I wanted to imagine it, with Marcin "Jankos" Jankowski representing G2, who I wished to win the next World Championship. Around him I created six champions of League of Legends (Jarvan IV, Akali, Nidalee, Kayn, Olaf and Sejuani) in the style of G2, and hid the name of the part "Rise again" in two of the blades of the champions.



#### Past - Present - Future

The whole piece, my biggest project so far, contains ten player portraits, more than fifteen fan comissions in four parts telling the story of LEC teams losing and trying to succeed again. I made it to tell a dramatic story, to show support to the european League of Legends teams and to entertain the fans of LEC and World Championship by offering them a riddle game in my work. I uploaded the single parts one by one in a time span of four weeks throughout the tournament to finish it with the full piece last.

The whole project took more than 190h to complete.
